Violators will be subject to an Event Committee hearing for endangering the Club's ability to hold events at this site. Please respect this area by cleaning up after your dog. Dogs must be on leash at all times.

General Tracking and Cautionary Disclaimers are as follows:

No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead" – due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.

Cancellation of Event may occur due to extreme hazardous weather conditions as determined by the Tracking Committee and Judges.

LIMITATIONS ON ENTRIES

Entries will close Wednesday Sept 29, 2010 at 5:00PM. The draw will be conducted at the N1356 US 14, Walworth, WI 53184 on Wednesday Sept 29, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, substituted or altered after the stated closing date and time.

Entry is limited to AKC registered dogs at least six month of age or older who have earned a TD title. This Test is limited to (8) VST tracks. Dogs having their VST titles will not be barred from competition, but dogs not having earned their VST titles will be given preference for entry for this test.

Entries must be made on an official American Kennel Club entry form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent. Conditional, unsigned, telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. There will be a \$25.00 fee imposed for returned checks. All entries must be paid in full prior to showing.

Bitches in season may participate provided that the Test Secretary and Judges are notified that a bitch in season is present prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track shall be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

Entries will be acknowledged and a judging program will be mailed as stated in the regulations. Should you have any questions please contact the Test Secretary, Debbie Maheu at dlmaheu@gmail.com

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly. No video taping of this event will be allowed without prior permission of the Test Secretary and the judges.

The test worker draw option, as allowed by the AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 13d, will be used in this test for club members and other workers as defined by the club's Board of Directors and published as Club Policy in the club minutes and newsletter.

Directions to Site: University of Wisconsin- Whitewater

From Chicago take I-90 West to Exit 171A. Then take Hwy 26N to Milton. At stoplight, turn right onto Hwy 59 East to Whitewater. Turn left on Main St, then right on Prairie St to E. Schwager. Turn right onto E. Schwager and park by the Lawcon picnic area.

From Madison take I-90 East to Exit 163 (Milton/Edgerton exit). Take Hwy 59 east, then left onto County "N" to Whitewater. Turn left at Indian Mound Parkway, right onto Hwy 12 (Main St). Past stoplight in front of McDonald's, turn left onto Prairie St. to E. Schwager. Turn right onto E. Schwager and park by the Lawcon picnic area.

From Milwaukee take I-43 South. At East Troy, take Hwy 20 W, then Hwy 12 W to Whitewater where it becomes Main Street. Continue on and turn right at stoplight on Prairie St. to E. Schwager. Turn right onto W. Schwager and park by the Lawcon picnic area.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
